



**NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE REVIEW OF THE TARIFF
METHODOLOGY FOR PETROLEUM STORAGE AND LOADING FACILITY TARIFFS SCHEDULED
16 JANUARY 2020**
