



## **ROMPCO (PTY) LTD'S APPLICATION FOR A GAS TRANSMISSION AGREEMENT 3 ('GTA 3') TRANSMISSION TARIFF IN TERMS OF THE GAS ACT, 2001 (ACT NO. 48 OF 2001)**

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

Notice is hereby given that NERSA has received a transmission tariff application from the Republic of Mozambique Pipeline Investments Company ('ROMPCO'), for the following:

1. An application to approve the piped-gas transmission tariff for volumes arising from investment in Loop Line 2 (GTA3) for the period **1 January 2020 to 31 December 2022**.
