



## INVITATION TO COMMENT ON LICENCE APPLICATIONS AND THE APPLICATIONS FOR THE AMENDMENT OF LICENCE CONDITIONS

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

NERSA is currently considering the applications mentioned below, and is giving the members of the public and stakeholders an opportunity to make written presentations prior to NERSA making a decision on the said applications.
