## Refined Fuels Consumption

**Key View:** We hold the view that South African refined fuels consumption will remain below its potential, with disproportionately high fuel prices and a weak economic growth outlook over the next five years restricting demand.

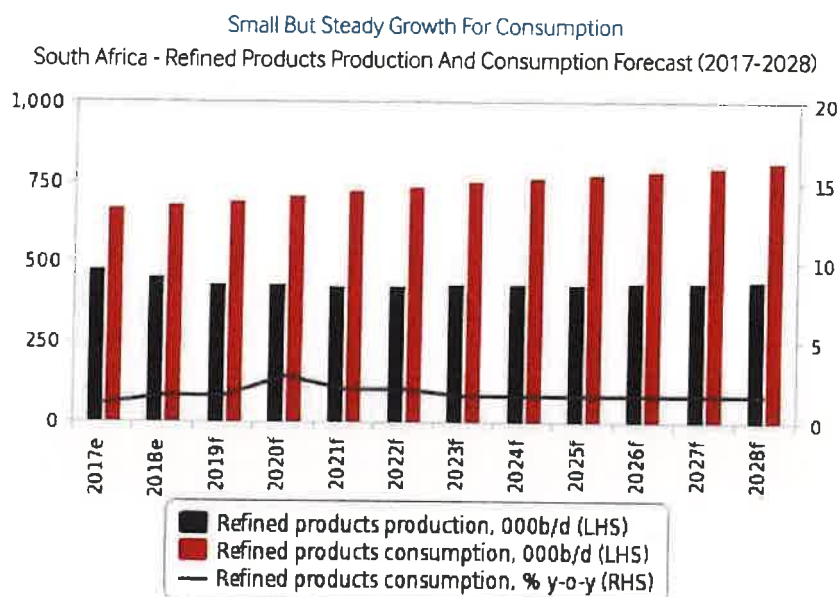
### Latest Updates

- We hold our bearish forecasts for the refined fuels consumption in South Africa and expect consumption growth to average 1.8% per annum over the coming decade.
- Total fuels consumption will rise from 692.730b/d in 2019 to 817.040b/d in 2028.
- In relative terms, the cost of fuel in South Africa remains prohibitively high and this will constrain stronger consumption growth.

### Structural Trends

We forecast a continued growth in refined fuels consumption in South Africa, averaging 1.8% across the 2019-2028 period.

South Africans face prohibitively high fuel prices in relation to the national average income. In Q219, gasoline in South Africa reportedly remained new record highs of ZAR15.8 per litre. As a result, South African authorities are under constant pressure to cut down the fuel prices, which are driving inflation in the country.



High fuel prices, combined with constrained growth in the South African mining and construction sectors (both key drivers of fuel demand), create a subdued outlook for fuel demand in the country. Subsequently, the profitability of the country's refining sector is under increasing pressure. Additionally, operating costs in the sector continue to grow, with ageing refineries, low complexity, a high level of unionisation in the workforce, frequent industrial action and repeated power outages - all raising costs and undercutting profitability in the sector.

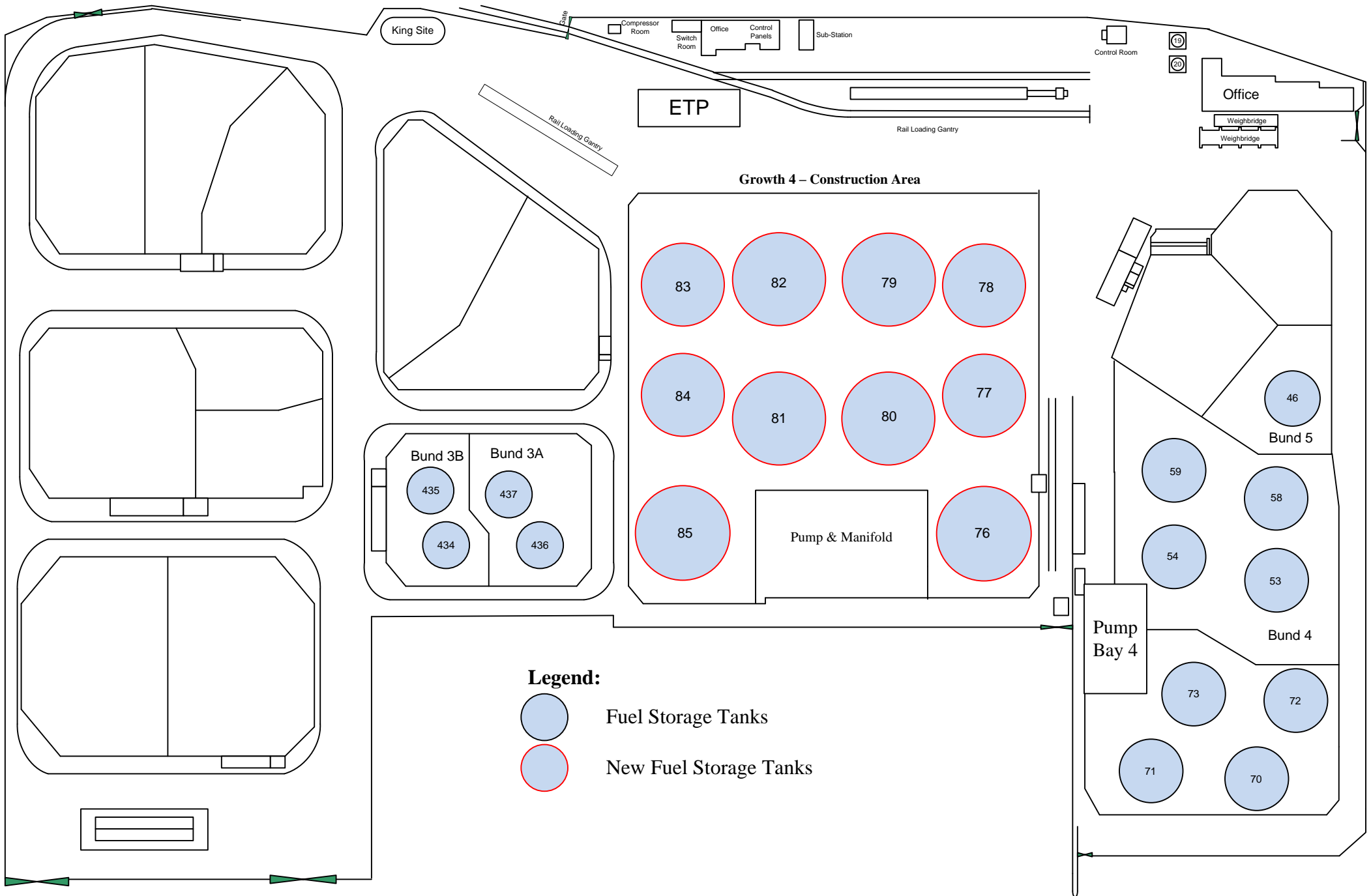
