

## **INVITATION TO COMMENT ON TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR PETROLEUM PIPELINE AND STORAGE FACILITIES**

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA or 'the Energy Regulator') is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator invites the public to comment on the following tariff applications:

- **Vopak South Africa Developments (Pty) Ltd** tariff application for its petroleum storage facility for the period 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2022 tariff period; and
- **Vopak South Africa Developments (Pty) Ltd** tariff application for its petroleum pipeline facility for the period 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2022 tariff period.
