
INVITATION TO COMMENT ON TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR PETROLEUM PIPELINE LOADING AND STORAGE FACILITIES

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA or 'the Energy Regulator') is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator invites the public to comment on the tariff applications by **Shell Downstream (Pty) Ltd** for its petroleum storage facilities in Alberton, Kroonstad and Witbank for the 1 January 2020 to 30 December 2020 tariff period;
