



Invitation for written stakeholder comments

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

NERSA has published consultation papers on the following regulatory matters for stakeholders to submit written comments: -

1. Eskom's third Multi-Year Price Determination (MYPD3) Regulatory Clearing Account (RCA) Year 2 (2014/15), Year 3 (2015/16) and Year 4 (2016/17) applications;
2. Eskom's Supplementary application; and
3. The implementation plan for liquidation of the 2018/19 RCA balance

NERSA will collate all comments received, which will be taken into consideration when the decision is made. NERSA will also hold public hearings using any acceptable public consultation mechanism in line with the COVID-19 restrictions and applicable government regulations; wherein presentations may be made by interested and affected parties. The process for the consultation and decision-making is outlined in the consultation papers.
